When Abu Bakr as-Siddiq became caliph, some tribes that had newly adopted Islam turned back from Islam. In the eleventh Hijri year, a battle took place at Al-Yamamah between the renegades led by Musaylima (the Liar) and the Muslims under the leadership of Khalid bin Al-Walid (may Allah's blessings be upon him). In that battle, seventy Quran reciters were martyred.
