In his introduction to this new edition of Leon Krier's 1985 monograph Albert Speer □ Architecture, Robert Stern points out, quite rightly, that Krier has never worked for, nor flirted with any currently existing totalitarian regimes; nor is he grandiose as a designer or urban planner. Rather, he bravely tries to tackle the quandary of whether "a war criminal can be a great artist".

Krier, a traditionally minded architect and urbanist who perhaps is known best as master planner of Poundbury in Dorchester, England, interviewed Speer in the early 1980s as he explored the elderly German's ambitious plans, devised in close concert with Hitler, to transform Berlin into the capital of Europe.

Leon Krier does not look much like an architect. Most of them dress in a now somewhat dated all-black Yohji Yamamoto manner. Krier by contrast wears a lot of linen, and he has the wire-frame glasses, broad-brimmed hats and neck stock associated with minor characters in Merchant Ivory adaptations.

Krier's enthusiasm for Speer was (and still is) controversial. His position: The Nazis spoiled classicism for the rest of us, in an unfair case of guilt by association. "Classical architecture was implicitly condemned by the Nuremberg tribunals to a heavier sentence than Speer the Reichsminister," he wrote in his original essay.

On the other hand, Krier has invoked, even deliberately emulated, Heinrich Tessenow, Albert Speer's consistently anti-Nazi teacher (whose opinion of his ex-assistant's architectural achievement was no better than mine) on the need to limit city size and city growth; yet he does not seem to have heeded the lesson which Tessenow, like Ebenezer Howard (his contemporary), insistently repeated: that for any human settlement — village, town or city — to have any vitality, it must be productive.
