Which research method should I choose? It depends on your research goal. It depends on what subjects (and who) you want to study. Let's say you are interested in studying what makes people happy, or why some students are more conscious about recycling on campus. To answer these questions, you need to make a decision about how to collect your data. Most frequently used methods include: Observation / Participant Observation; Surveys; Interviews; Focus Groups; Experiments
